

Practice Turf Introduction

CR515, CR516, CR517 & CR550

Practice Turf System Cross Section



This system uses a dense concrete base slab 100mm thick over which a needle punched fibre carpet is laid. This is available either fully bonded to the base slab with special adhesive, or as an alternative roll up/roll down surface with a heavy PVC backing.

The system is designed to offer predictable playing characteristics coupled with a high degree of vandal resistance, and very low maintenance requirements.

It is a suitable system to consider for low level school use in practice or for match use, or for the recreational cricket in unsupervised areas like parks.

Practice Turf Synthetic Component Specification

PRACTICE TURF CARPET – REF: CR515, CR516 & CR517

Resin bonded needle punched 100% UV stabilised polypropylene fibres.

Width - 2.74m

Total thickness - 7mm

Total weight - 1.2kg/m²

QUICK TACK CARPET ADHESIVE - REF: CR550

Moisture curing, solvent based, rapid curing contact adhesive for cricket carpets in 20 litre drums. Coverage rate - approximately 40m² per 20 litre drum, depending upon base finish.
